

## NEW ELECTRONIC PAYMENT AND BILLING SERVICES



### It's fast, easy and secure!

The City of Antigo Water & Sewer Utility will be offering new electronic payment and billing services in conjunction with Payment Services Network.

We also will offer the option of receiving an email when your statement is ready for viewing online rather than receiving a paper bill in the mail.

### New viewing and payment options will include:

- Online 
- Calling 
- Mobile device with app from App Store® or Google Play™

### What will you be able to do?

- View your water bill online
- View the amount you owe online or on the payment app
- Pay from your checking or savings account (FREE service).
- Pay by debit or credit card with a convenience fee of 2.75% + 50¢ if under \$100
- Pay immediately, schedule a payment or set up Auto-Pay (automatic recurring payments)
- Print bills and receipts by going online
- Opt out of receiving paper bills—you would receive an email each time a new bill is ready to view

## Cold Temperatures Can Cause Pipes to Freeze

As the weather gets colder and homes are vacant, it is important to take extra precautions in regard to pipes freezing. Sometimes furnaces fail when needed most and result in frozen and broken pipes and significant damage to homes.

## Tax Payments

If you would like a receipt for payment on your property taxes, please send a stamped, self-addressed envelope along with your payment stub and check.

If paying in person, a receipt will be provided upon payment.

If your escrow company is sending us payment on your taxes, a receipt is available in our office.

Payments can also be made by debit or credit card (with a convenience fee of 2.5%) or by eChecking or eSavings account (FREE service).

## Winter Overnight Parking

A winter parking ban is in effect from November 1 through March 31. During this time parking is not allowed on City streets from 2:30 am to 7:00 am. Overnight parking is allowed in municipal lots that are specifically designated for permit parking only. Permits will be issued on a first-come, first-serve basis. Each parking permit will specify the designated area for parking.

You may request permission from the Antigo Police Department to park your vehicle on the street for up to three times per season. Dispatch will be keeping a log of these requests.

If you have consumed alcohol, please leave your vehicle parked and get a safe ride home. Call dispatch with vehicle information. Any questions, please call the Police Department at 715-627-6411.

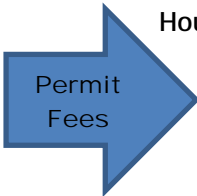

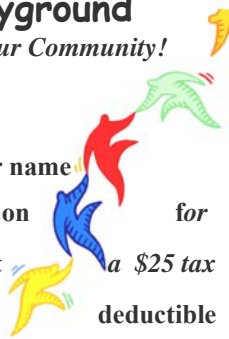

**LOOKING FORWARD....**

Just wanted to remind residents that storage tents such as those sold by local vendors to store cars, seasonal equipment are not allowed in the city per Sec. 14-746 (d):

*Use restrictions in residential district. Accessory uses or structures in residential districts shall not involve the conduct of any business, trade or industry except for home occupations and shall not be occupied as a dwelling unit. Accessory buildings shall not be used for residential purposes. Under no circumstances may a tent be used as a dwelling or an accessory structure.*

In 2017, one of the areas of concentration for my department will be the enforcement of Sec. 38-408 of the municipal code. This section is directed toward the storage of automobiles and inoperable appliances. If you have vehicles or appliances that need to be removed from your property, please take note that now is a good time to address the issue.

*(a) Storage of automobiles restricted. No disassembled, inoperable, unlicensed, junked or wrecked motor vehicles, race cars, race trucks, demo derby cars, truck bodies, tractors, trailers, farm machinery, vehicle parts or tires or appliances shall be stored unenclosed outside of a building upon industrial, commercial, public or private residential property within the city for a period exceeding ten days unless it is in connection with an authorized business enterprise located in a properly zoned area maintained in such a manner as to not constitute a public nuisance.*

*(b) Definitions. The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:*

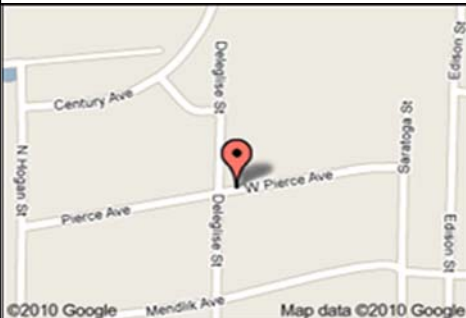
**Disassembled, inoperable, junked or wrecked motor vehicles, truck bodies, tractors, or trailers**-motor vehicles, recreational vehicles, truck bodies, tractors, farm machinery or trailers in such a state of physical or mechanical ruin as to be incapable of propulsion, being operated upon the public streets or highways, or which are otherwise not in safe or legal condition for operation on public streets or highways due to missing or inoperative parts, flat or removed tires, expired or missing license plates or other defects.

**Inoperable appliance**-any stove, washer, refrigerator or other appliance which is no longer operable in the sense for which it was manufactured.

**Motor vehicle**-as defined in Wis. Stats. § 340.01(35).

**Race car, race truck or demo derby car or truck**-any standard car or truck modified to allow for competition in any kind of racing activity.

**Unlicensed motor vehicles, truck bodies, tractors or trailers**-motor vehicles, truck bodies, tractors, recreational vehicles or trailers, race cars, race trucks, demo derby cars which do not bear lawful current license plates.
