The following materials have been banned from disposal in Wisconsin landfills and must be recycled:






Paper

-  office paper
-  newspaper
-  magazines
-  corrugated cardboard

Containers

-  aluminum cans
-  steel (tin) cans
-  glass bottles and jars
-  plastic containers (#1 and #2)

Other Materials

-  major appliances
-  waste tires
-  lead-acid vehicle batteries
-  yard wastes
-  used motor oil



RECYCLE...
It's the LAW!!

FYI:

1 ton of recycled paper..... saves 17 trees.
10 pounds of recycled plastic bottles..... save the energy equivalent to 200 gallons of gasoline.
1 aluminum cansaves enough energy to light a 100-watt bulb for 3.5 hours.
1 ton of recycled glass..... saves the energy equivalent to 10 gallons of gasoline.
