Springbrook Trail General Information

- The Springbrook Trail is open year-round at all hours. Please use caution at night.
- Walking or biking is at your own risk.

Walking/Biking Trail Common Courtesy

- Watch for other trail users.
- Travel at a leisurely pace.
- Slow down for blind corners and at intersections.
- Only pass on the left.
- Slow down and yield to pedestrians if you are on a bike.
- Alert pedestrians when you are about to pass with “bicycle on your left” or a bell.
- If you are biking in a group, ride single file if others are on the path.
- Keep dogs on a leash and please pick up pet waste.

Walking/Biking Trail Policies and Procedures

- *Trail Closing:* The Chief of Police, Mayor or Parks, Cemetery and Recreation Supervisor or his/her designee will have full authority to open and close any park, facility or area because of weather conditions, physical condition, construction or when, in the interest of public safety, it is deemed necessary.
- *Pets:* Each owner is responsible for cleaning up after their own pet and disposing of the pet waste in an appropriate trash receptacle. Pets should be on a leash at all times unless stated otherwise.
- *Park Property:* No person shall kill, injure, disturb or attempt to injure or disturb waterfowl, birds or animals, wild or domestic, within any park, except as permitted by this chapter. No person shall climb any tree or remove flowers or fruit, wild or cultivated, or break, cut down, trample upon, remove or in any manner injure, deface, write upon or ill use any tree, shrub, flower, flower bed, turf, soil, sand, fountain, ornament, building, structure, apparatus, bench, table, official notice, sign or other property within any property unless approved by the Park, Cemetery and Recreation Supervisor and/or designee.
- *Littering:* Depositing rubbish or litter in any park or public property is prohibited. No person shall place or deposit any filth, ashes, embers, dirt, garbage, rubbish, paper or other litter, refuse or offensive matter in or on any park or other public property.
- *Vandalism:* Any acts of vandalism or mischief will not be tolerated by the City of Antigo. All acts of vandalism and mischief will be investigated and reported to local law enforcement. Destruction of property will also be investigated and reported to local law enforcement.
