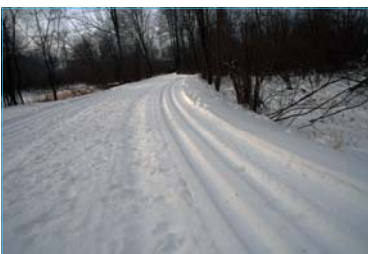
## Winter Wonderland

**Location:** Off First Avenue (between Edison and Dorr Street)

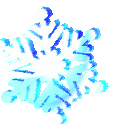


## X-Country Skiing

**Springbrook Walking Trail (North Section):** Over 2 miles of



groomed trail. All abilities.

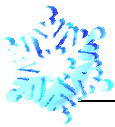

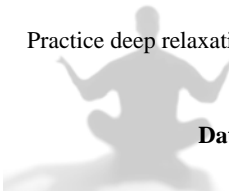
