

Basic Guidelines for Field Use

- Before leaving a field for the evening please make sure the following items are checked:
 - a. Make sure all maintenance/storage rooms are locked and closed. If a maintenance or storage room is left open you will be responsible for any items that are missing or damaged.
- All bases need to be removed from the playing field and placed in the maintenance or storage room at the end of every game or practice.
- The base markers need to be placed on the field once the bases are removed.
- Please do not remove bases from one field storeroom for use at another field. We now have accessible storage at each of the fields with the following equipment in each of the storerooms:
 - a. Bases
 - b. Limer
 - c. Lime
 - d. Rakes
- Please keep maintenance rooms as neat as possible. Our staff needs clear access to electrical breakers, water heaters and cleaning and maintenance supplies. We are also able to easily account for items and recognize if something is missing when storerooms are kept neat.
- When soft-tossing or using a tee please do not hit into the fence unless you are using a whiffle ball. Fencing is very expensive and we appreciate your cooperation to maximize the life of our facilities.
- Please let us know about cancellations as soon as possible, so we can show an opening for the field.

The following lists the facilities and what storerooms require a key or access code (only head coaches will be given a key).

- Lake Park Lights – Access Code
- Senior League Storeroom – Master Lock - Code
- Senior League Press Box – Access Code
- Senior League Concession – Master Lock - Code
- Little League Storeroom – Access Code
- Little League Press Box – Access Code
- Little League Concession – Access Code
- Saratoga Storage – Access Code
- North Clermont – Access Code

The following fields are designated as softball, baseball or both. Baseball will not be allowed to move or remove mounds from designated softball fields (unless authorized to do so during designated tournaments and with a completed contract/agreement on file with the City of Antigo). Due to limited field availability softball and/or baseball may play on a field that is designated for the other program (i.e. softball may play on Al Remington Little League Field, which is a designated baseball field).

- Saratoga South - Softball
- Senior League – Baseball
- Al Remington Little League – Baseball
