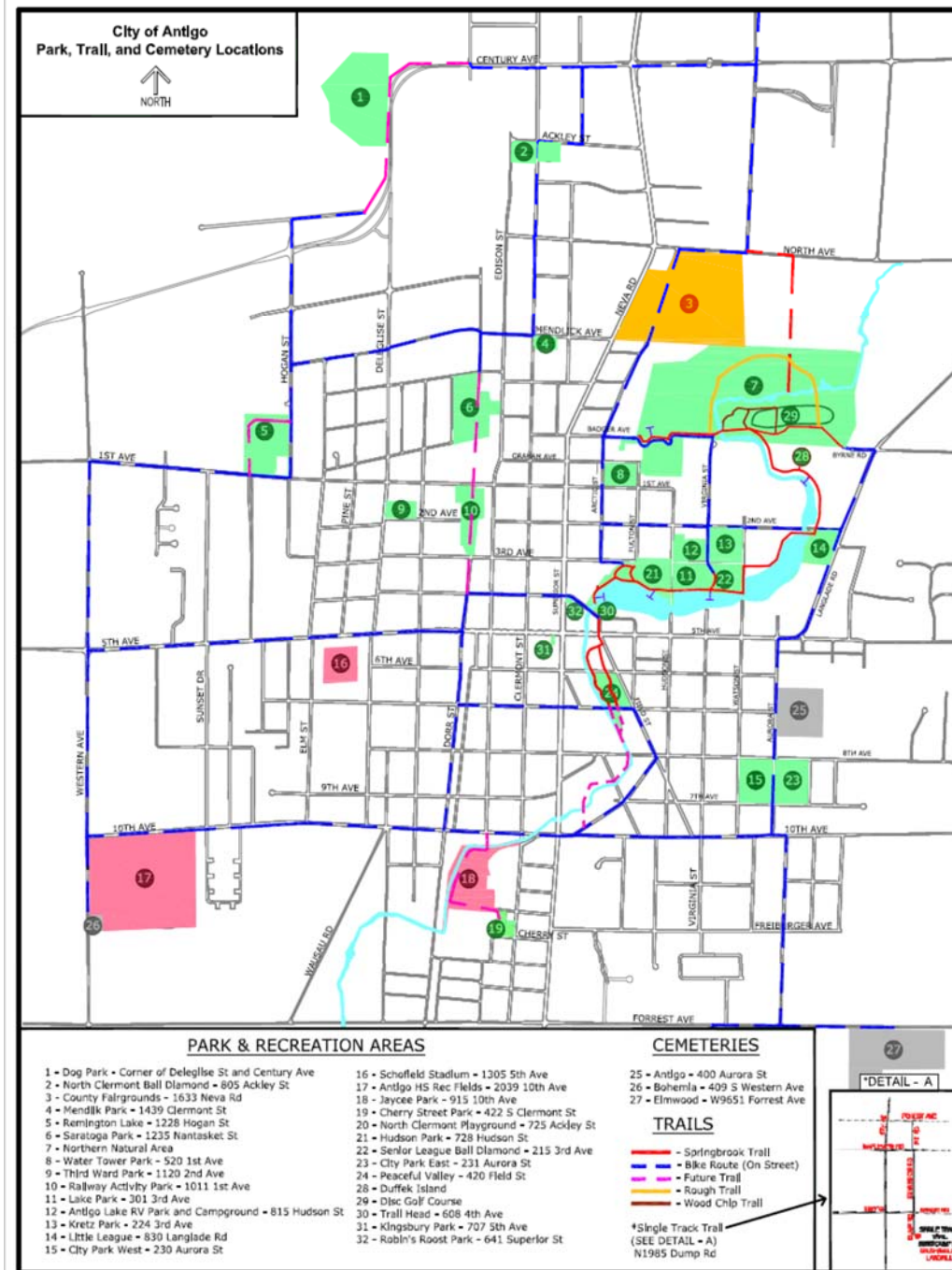


# City of Antigo Peaceful Valley Park & Festival Grounds

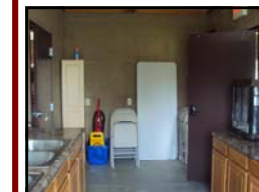
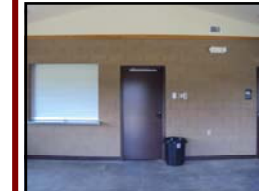


Our newest park area is the Peaceful Valley Park & Event Center. Located between 5th & 8th Avenue along Field Street. The total park area is approximately 4.54 acres and covers a 3 block area. Springbrook Trail winds through this area and is paved for both pedestrian and bicycle use.

## Peaceful Valley Warming House

## Peaceful Valley Heinzen Pavilion

The Peaceful Valley Heinzen Pavilion was funded through a Knowles Stewardship Grant, a donation by Mr. and Mrs. Don Heinzen, the Remington Foundation, timber sale funds, and City of Antigo Capital Improvement funds. We are very grateful for the funding and support, which allowed our community to construct a facility that is utilized for a variety of events, programs, and activities.



## Reservation Policies and Fees

The Warming House, Heinzen Pavilion and Festival Grounds may be reserved by the public for family, social, or community events.

### Fees

#### Warming House:

\$60 per day for residents and \$90 per day for non-residents.

#### Festival Grounds (electric is an additional \$25):

\$50 per day for residents and \$75 per day for non-residents

#### Heinzen Peaceful Valley Pavilion:

\$75/\$85 per day for residents and \$112.50/127.50 per day for non-residents

### Event Permit / Street Use Permit:

An Event Permit is required if you are inviting the general public to your event. If you would like to close/block the streets you will need to complete a street use permit. The Street Use Permit requires Common Council approval, so it is recommended you apply at least 90 days in advance. \$25.00

### Insurance Requirements:

\$1,000,000 general liability and The City of Antigo listed as "Additional Insured".

Also, there is a **minimum fee of \$100.00 for non-emergency call-outs** to the Park and Recreation staff after hours.

### Dates/Season

Spring - Fall

### Reservations

We will hold a reservation request for five business days. If we have not received the full payment at the end of five business days, you will forfeit your reservation. You may reserve on-line on our website: ([www.antigo-city.org/recl](http://www.antigo-city.org/recl)), at our office (700 Edison Street), or via phone.

### Forms and Payment

We require a completed reservation form along with the payment and any other special permits required for the event. You may pay on-line on our website, at our office (700 Edison Street), or via phone. We accept all major credit cards.

## Peaceful Valley Park & Festival Grounds Amenities

**PARK LOCATION:** In between 5th Avenue and 8th Avenue

**WARMING HOUSE & HEINZEN PAVILION LOCATION:** Park  
**Address:** 420 Field Street; between 6th and 7th Ave

**TOTAL PARK ACREAGE:** Approximately 3 acres (includes both the northern parking area and the vacant lot south of 7th Avenue).

**PARK HOURS:** 7:00 am - Dusk, unless you have a valid park facility reservation.

**SHELTER / PAVILION / RESTROOM HOURS:**

7:00 am - 8:30 pm (hours may be extended with a valid reservation)

*Note: The City of Antigo is not responsible for any personal items left after closing hours.*

**WARMING HOUSE / CONCESSION AMENITIES:**

**Dimensions of interior area:** 28' x 18'

**Serving Area / Counter**

**Serving Window:** Located on the west side of the building; allows for outside access from the kitchen.

**Roll-up Concession Door:** Separates main warming room from kitchen.

**Refrigerator with Freezer**

**Microwave**

**Sinks:** 2 sinks with 4 basins; ample counter space

**Electric:** 120 volt electrical duplex outlets are located throughout the warming house facility.

- 5, in the concession area.

- 7, in the warming area.

- 4, on the exterior of the building.

**Lighting:** Lighting is on a photo sensor for both the interior and exterior of the warming house.

**Tables:** 24 chairs and 5 tables are available with the shelter reservation.

**Bench:** Runs along length of west wall.

**Restrooms:** Men's and Women's restrooms are located on exterior north-side of building; one unisex restroom is located in interior of building.

**Large garbage cans**

**PARK & FESTIVAL GROUNDS AMENITIES:**

**Electric:**

- *Northern Parking Lot (Additional \$25.00 fee for electrical capabilities in Northern Parking Lot):*

- 48, 20 amp duplex outlets; separate circuits

- 3, 4 wire 50 amp service outlets

- *Warming House:* See above

**Lighting:** Street lights and trail lights are on dusk to dawn sensors.

**Parking Areas / Spaces:**

- *Northern Parking Lot:* 108 Parking Spaces

- *Small lot off of 6th Avenue:* 15 Parking Spaces

- *Adjacent to Rockin' Robin Playground:*

- 31 Parking Spaces

- Additional on street parking surrounding park

**Raised Stage Area:** Accessible electric with raised brick patio area.

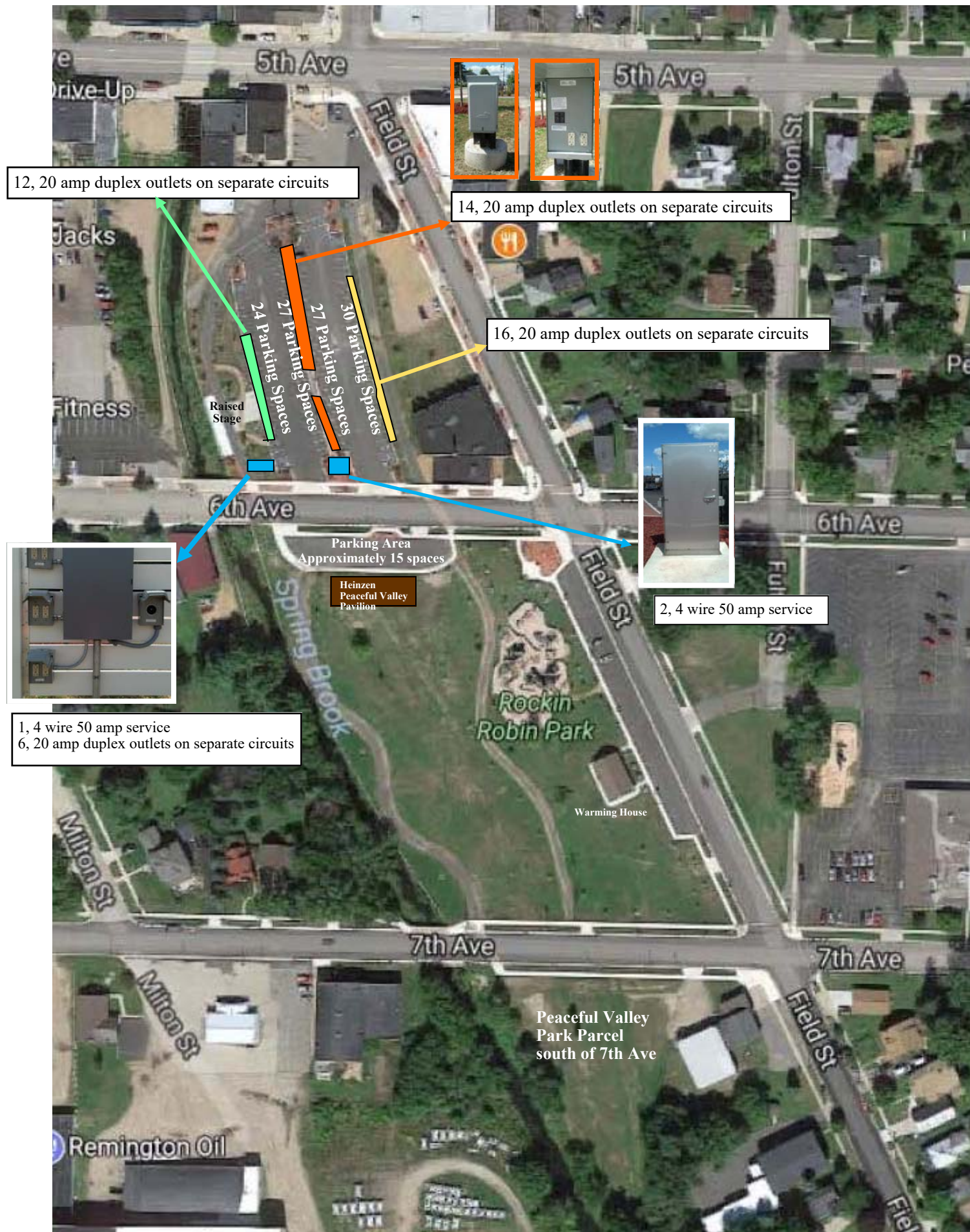
**Picnic tables:** Located throughout the park.

**Benches:** Located throughout the park.

**Temporary Event Tent Sites:** There are several areas available to place temporary tents

**Playground equipment:** Large wooden and composite community built playground (**Rockin' Robin Playground / AKA Castle Park**)

**Walking / Bike Trail:** Springbrook Trail runs through the park & Festival Grounds.

**HEINZEN PEACEFUL VALLEY PAVILION AMENITIES:**

**Dimensions of interior area:** 40' X 80'

**Lighting:** Lighting is on a photo sensor for both the interior and exterior of the warming house.

**Tables:** 22, 6' Banquet tables and 6 chairs/table are available with the shelter reservation.

**Restrooms:** Men's and Women's restrooms are located on exterior north-side of the Warming House.

**Large garbage cans:** Located around the pavilion

**FANS:** Ceiling of Pavilion

**Electric:**

- 16, 20 amp duplex outlets; 12 separate circuits
- 8, 4 wire 30 amp service outlets

**Parking Areas / Spaces:**

- *Northern Parking Lot:* 108 Parking Spaces
- *Small lot off of 6th Avenue:* 15 Parking Spaces
- *Adjacent to Rockin' Robin Playground:* 31 Parking Spaces
- Additional on street parking surrounding park

**Picnic tables:** Located throughout the park.

**Benches:** Located throughout the park.

**Temporary Event Tent Sites:** There are several areas available to place temporary tents

**Playground equipment:** Large wooden and composite community built playground (**Rockin' Robin Playground / AKA Castle Park**)

**Walking / Bike Trail:** Springbrook Trail runs through the park & Festival Grounds.

## General Park Policies & Procedures

- Only City of Antigo authorized vehicles are allowed in the park. Other vehicles entering the park for the purpose of hauling food, refreshments, etc. to the shelters are subject to fine, unless stated otherwise by the Park and Recreation Supervisor.
- Noise levels from crowds, musical instruments, stereos, etc., must be kept to a moderate level.
- Nails, tacks, etc. are not to be used in or on the shelter, facilities or trees. If tape or string is used it must be removed.
- No park equipment, benches, seats or tables may be moved unless authorized by the Park, Cemetery and Recreation Department.
- If you are planning on having an event or party tent requiring stakes it is your responsibility to contact Diggers Hotline (1-800-242-8511) prior to the event.
- All persons using a park shelter or ball field will relinquish their use to the holder of a facility reservation form.
- Glass beverage bottles or glass containers of any kind are not allowed in our parks for the safety of those utilizing our facilities.
- Fires must be contained within grills and shall be used only in designated picnic areas. Coals must be thoroughly extinguished to prevent fire or damage to any park property.
- Camping in all city parks is prohibited, except in the city campground, unless prior authorization by the Common Council is granted for a special event permit and the appropriate permits have been completed.
